

Theme Ideas

God's love creates a generous dwelling place. John writes of Jesus' love as a reality in which we abide, even as we provide this abode for others. This abode of love is a place of joy as well as of obedience given willingly—not out of the fear that separates servant from master, but out of the understanding that grows between us All Siblings of Christ: Jesus and his disciples. First John describes an even closer relationship: believers are born to our parent God. The story of Cornelius's baptism adds the detail of spaciousness: the abode of love welcomes all peoples. The psalmist expands God's caring attention beyond the house of Israel to the entire globe!


